RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE COMPETITIONS

1. COLOURFUL INDIA

Time Limit-Max 2 mins

- Children should come dressed up in related costume.
- Children should speak 2-3 lines about the **state** they represent.
- JUDGEMENT CRITERIA
 1. Costume
 2. Speech Clarity
 3. Confidence

2. POEM RECITATION

Time Limit-Max 2 mins

- Poem should be based on the given theme.
- Selected poem can be in English, Hindi or Gujarati.
- Selected poem should not be from the text book.
- Once informed, a hard copy of the poem shall be submitted to the class teacher before the competition.
- JUDGEMENT CRITERIA
 1. Memory
 2. Content
 3. Intonation and Voice Modulation
 4. Pronunciation
 5. Overall Presentation (eye contact, audibility, etc.)

2. PAPER LANTERN MAKING

Time Limit-1 hour

- Decoration with eatables will not be allowed.
- Regular (white/colour) paper, chart paper or hand-made paper to be brought from home without any decoration.
- Child will have to attach or write his/her name, Std. and Roll no. on the prepared item.
- JUDGEMENT CRITERIA
 1. Neatness
 2. Innovation and Creativity
 3. Presentation

3. HANDWRITING [COMPULSARY FOR ALL]

Time Limit-1 hour

- Content will be given on the spot.
- Cursive writing is compulsory for all.
- Children will have to bring 4-line paper (pin page) from home.
